

## Creating a Windows 95 Shortcut for DataCAD 7

1. Using the right mouse button, click on your Windows 95 desktop.
2. Choose **New** and then **Shortcut**.
3. Click **Browse**.
4. Double-click on your DataCAD directory name.
5. Double-click on the **RUNDCAD.BAT** file.
6. Click **Next**.
7. Enter a name for your DataCAD shortcut.
8. Click **Next**.
9. Choose an icon for your DataCAD shortcut.
10. Click **Finish**. Your DataCAD shortcut will now appear on the desktop.
11. Using the right mouse button, click on your DataCAD shortcut.
12. Choose **Properties**.
13. Choose the **Program** tab.
  - The first line is the name of your shortcut.
  - On the Run line, choose maximized.
  - Check the Close On Exit box.
14. Choose the **Memory** tab.
  - Keep everything set to “auto”.
  - Leave Protected unchecked.
  - Check Use HMA
15. Choose the **Screen** tab.
  - Check the Full-screen box.
16. Choose the **Misc** tab.
  - Set the **Idle Sensitivity** option to LOW.
17. Click **OK**.
18. Double-clicking on this shortcut will now start DataCAD from Windows 95.

### Mouse settings for DataCAD 7 under Windows 95

- If you are using a Logitech mouse, get the latest Windows 95 version of mouse software.
- To increase the speed of your Logitech mouse in DataCAD 7, add the following line to the Autoexec.bat file or as the first line of the DataCAD Rundcad.bat file:

```
set dc-mouse=4
```

- To get the middle mouse button to Object Snap in DataCAD, unassign the middle mouse button in the Windows 95 Control Panel.
