## **Conventional Memory**

Windows 95 loads its own 32-bit drivers for most hardware (i.e. CD-ROM), so you do not need to load a DOS 16-bit TSR. I would recommend making the following changes to your AUTOEXEC.BAT and CONFIG.SYS files. If there are any lines in these files other than those listed below, type **rem** followed by a space in front of each line to tell the computer to ignore them. (If there are problems with a specific program, you can come back and remove the **rem** from a particular line.) To edit your AUTOEXEC.BAT and CONFIG.SYS:

- 1. Go to Start, Run.
- 2. Type sysedit and press [Enter] to open your System Configuration Editor.
- 3. The top window is your AUTOEXEC.BAT file; make the changes below and choose File, Save.
- 4. You can now select the CONFIG.SYS file by clicking on the blue bar with its name.
- 5. Make the changes below and choose File, Save.
- 6. When you have finished, close the System Configuration Editor and then Shutdown your computer and reboot.

AUTOEXEC.BAT path c:\; c:\datacad set dc-mouse=4 set dcad\_root=c:\datacad

(Where datacad is your DataCAD directory.)
