Some customers are calling with problems of getting their Microsoft Bus Mouse to work. The problem appears to be caused by the new Version 7.0 of the Microsoft Mouse driver. Using an earlier version of the Microsoft Mouse driver solves the problem.

Some customers are also calling with problems in using CADKEY 3 (Version 3.5) with DOS (Version 3.2). Version 3.2 of DOS appears to be the cause of the problem. Reverting to Version 3.1 of DOS or upgrading to Version 3.3 of DOS solves the problem.

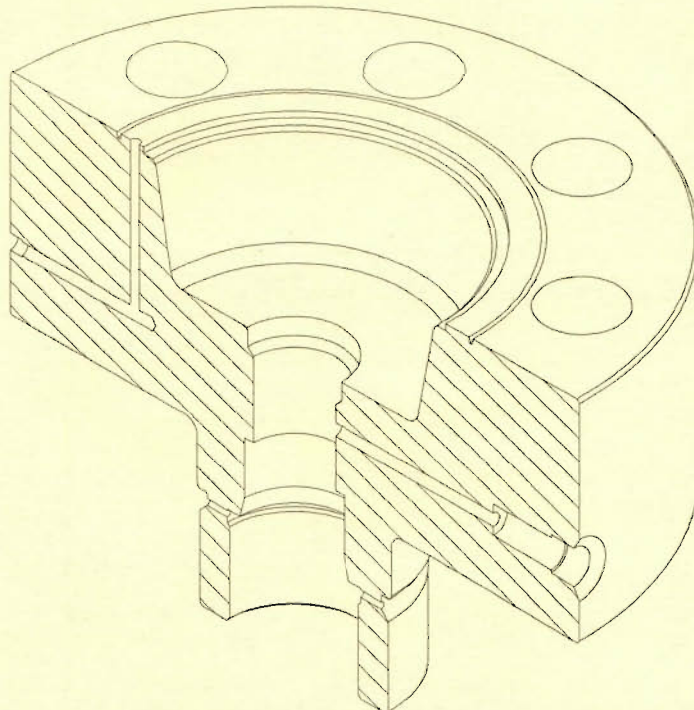
Have you heard what happened in Houston?

CADKEY-AutoCAD "Shootout" Becomes CADKEY Demonstration!

The South Texas Section of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers meets every third Thursday of the month. In addition to a main speaker, the ASME South Texas Section's monthly meetings include seven special-interest programs for each of the section's study groups: petroleum, engine and compressor, petroleum-production facilities, pressure vessels and piping, analytical and experimental mechanics, aerospace, and computers. Weldon Adair, Chairman of the ASME South Texas Section's Computer Study Group, thought that his group had a particularly interesting program scheduled for 8:00 p.m., Thursday, September 21, in Houston: a live competition between CADKEY[®] and AutoCAD[®]. He announced this event in the section's monthly newsletter.

Two local dealers, MLC CAD Systems (CADKEY) and Acratech (AutoCAD) had agreed in August to participate in the program. Each dealer was scheduled to bring his own equipment for the competition. Frank Adamek, Chairman of the South Texas Section, was to supply a B-sized drawing (created on AutoCAD) of a valve bonnet used on oilfield equipment as the "test" part. Weldon Adair had originally planned to furnish the participants with a hardcopy of the drawing by the beginning of September, if possible, to give them time to become familiar with it. The drawing was very complex, and the time for the competition at the meeting would be limited. "During the meeting they would only have about 30 minutes to do the drawing," Frank Adamek said. "The winner would be the one who progressed the farthest." The drawing became available much later than expected. Weldon Adair delivered the drawing to both dealers two days before the meeting.

On Thursday, September 21, Michael Leesley and Steve Porter of MLC CAD Systems arrived at the ASME meeting. Acratech never appeared. The dominant question among the 73 members attending the ASME meeting was: "Why aren't they here?"
